Section 3 – Awards and Recognition – 5 points <ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Record all the awards and recognition received through 4-H involvement 	5	
Section 4 – Leadership – 15 points <ul style="list-style-type: none"> · List the type of leadership given such as volunteer, appointed, elected · Provides enough detail to give a clear picture of what the responsibilities and duties are of the leadership role · Only list leadership roles related to your 4-H involvement 	15	
Section 5 – Community Service – 15 points <ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Provides enough details to give a clear picture of what was accomplished · Service may be related to project or based on community needs · Only list community service related to your 4-H involvement 	15	
Section 6 – Non-4-H Experiences – 5 points <ul style="list-style-type: none"> · list the most significant non-4-H experiences such as leadership, community service, awards and recognition, and any other experiences/activity other than 4-H 	5	
Section 7 – My 4-H Story – 15 points <ul style="list-style-type: none"> · Gave a brief introduction and general overview of your 4-H project work · Highlights leadership and community service · Gives significant details to show growth and how 4-H has influenced their live · Submitted a new story each year & use up to 6 pages to summarize 4-H experience 	15
